Privacy Policy 2018

Your Personal Data and the Royal Welsh Yacht Club (RWYC)

Your confidentiality is protected by the Data Protection Act and, from 25 May 2018, the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) (Regulation (EU) 2016/679) and the Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations 2016 (PECR). Any personal information supplied by you to RWYC will be kept on file. RWYC will always store your personal details securely and delete them once they are no longer relevant or when requested by you. A record of members' and non-members contact details may be kept for historical purposes.

We will also ask you to consent to which ways you wish RWYC to communicate with you. You can opt out of any/all of our communications at any time by contacting the Hon Membership Secretary.

We will use the data to provide the service that you expect and will communicate with you in the way(s) you have agreed to. The data we hold will be used to send you newsletters, AGM information, notice and organisation of Club events and sailing/rowing information, etc.

RWYC will only allow your information to be used for RWYC purposes and others working on our behalf and will only share them if required to do so by law. We will never share your information with other third party organisations for marketing purposes.
